Takács, János (Hungary)

János Takács graduated in economics at Bolyai” University of Cluj (Kolozsvár), Transsylvania and received second diploma at the University of Economic Sciences of Budapest. He attended several Management Programs of General Electric (G. E.) in the USA.

He was working in G. E. – Tungstam Co. Ltd. Budapest, in G. E. Lighting Co. Cleveland, Ohio, in IBM Hungary Ltd. and in Kőbányai Brewery Ltd. Budapest in leading management positions.

Now he is General Manager of Electrolux Hungary and Regional Chief Administrative Officer of Electrolux Central Eastern Europe (Croatia, Czech Republic, Poland, Hungary, Romania, Slovakia, Turkey). He is also Member of the Electrolux Boards in the Region.

János Takács has several other functions, e.g. Chairman of the Hungarian European Business Council, President of the Swedish Chamber of Commerce in Hungary, Member of different Boards of the Miskolc University and Budapest Corvinus University as well as Vice President of the “National Association of Employers and Industrialists and of the “Hungarian Association of International Companies”.

He received high level awards and honours, e.g. “Officers Cross” Order of the Hungarian Republic and became “Manager of the Year 2005” elected by the National Association of Managers.
